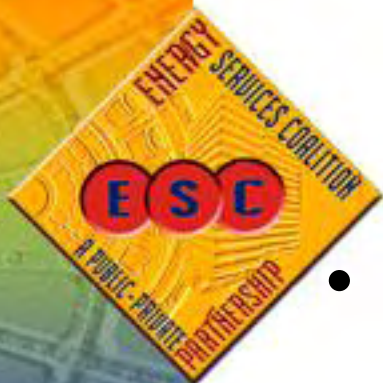

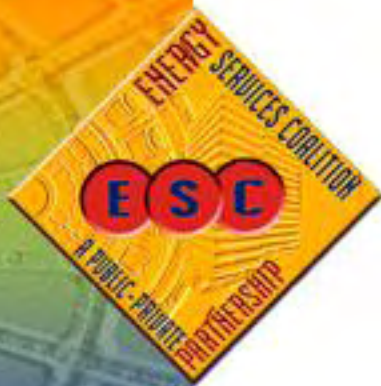

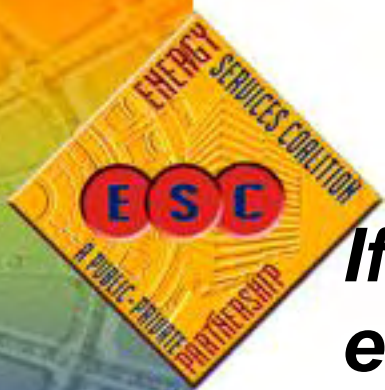
Colorado GEO Greening Government Goal

By June 30, 2012, reduce energy consumption in state facilities by 20% from SFY 05-06 baseline. Where performance contracting is not feasible, state agencies shall strive to reduce energy use by 10% from a fiscal year 2005-2006 baseline.

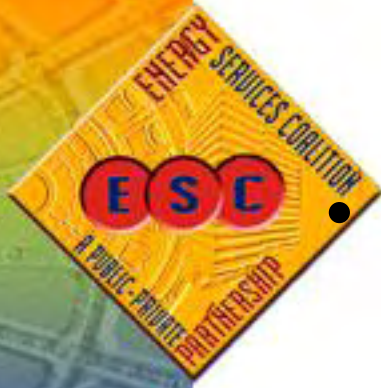

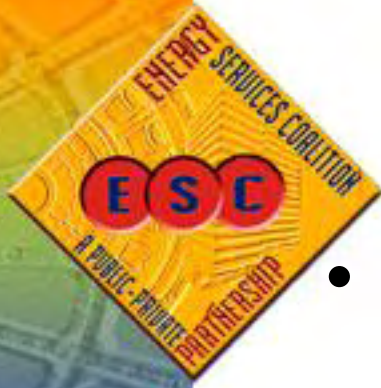

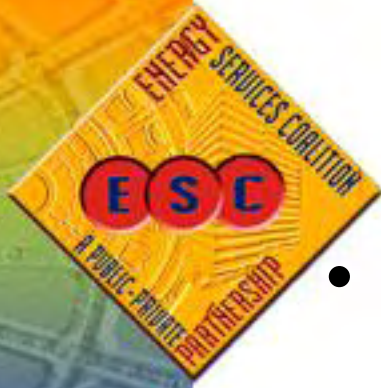

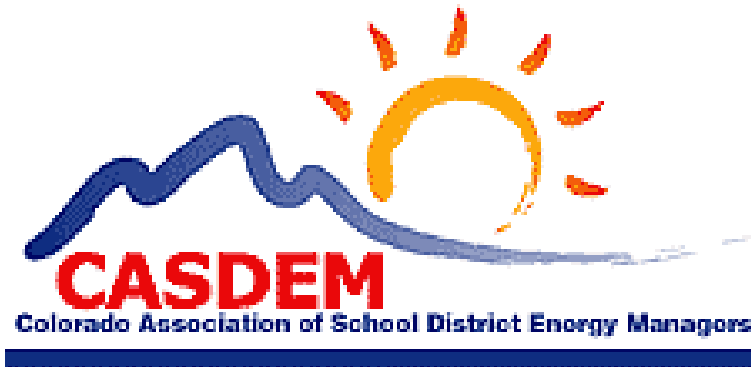

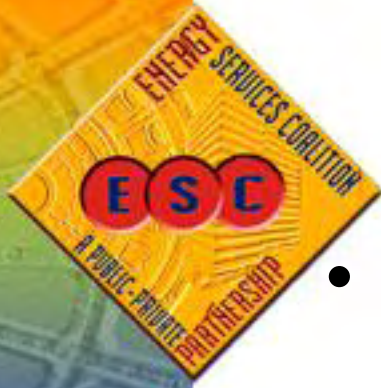

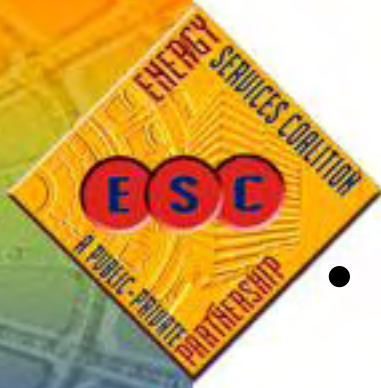


- ***Portion of U.S. annual energy use created by the combustion of fossil fuels: 86 percent***

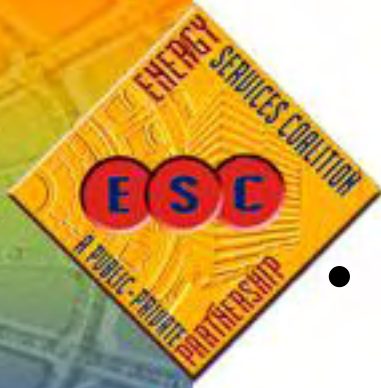


- ***Amount greenhouse gas emissions have increased between 1970 and 2004: 70 percent***

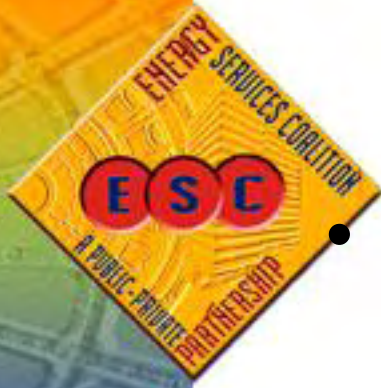
